




Good morning, Freedom Kids!

Today we will be thinking about church - not as a building but instead as a group of people who follow Jesus.

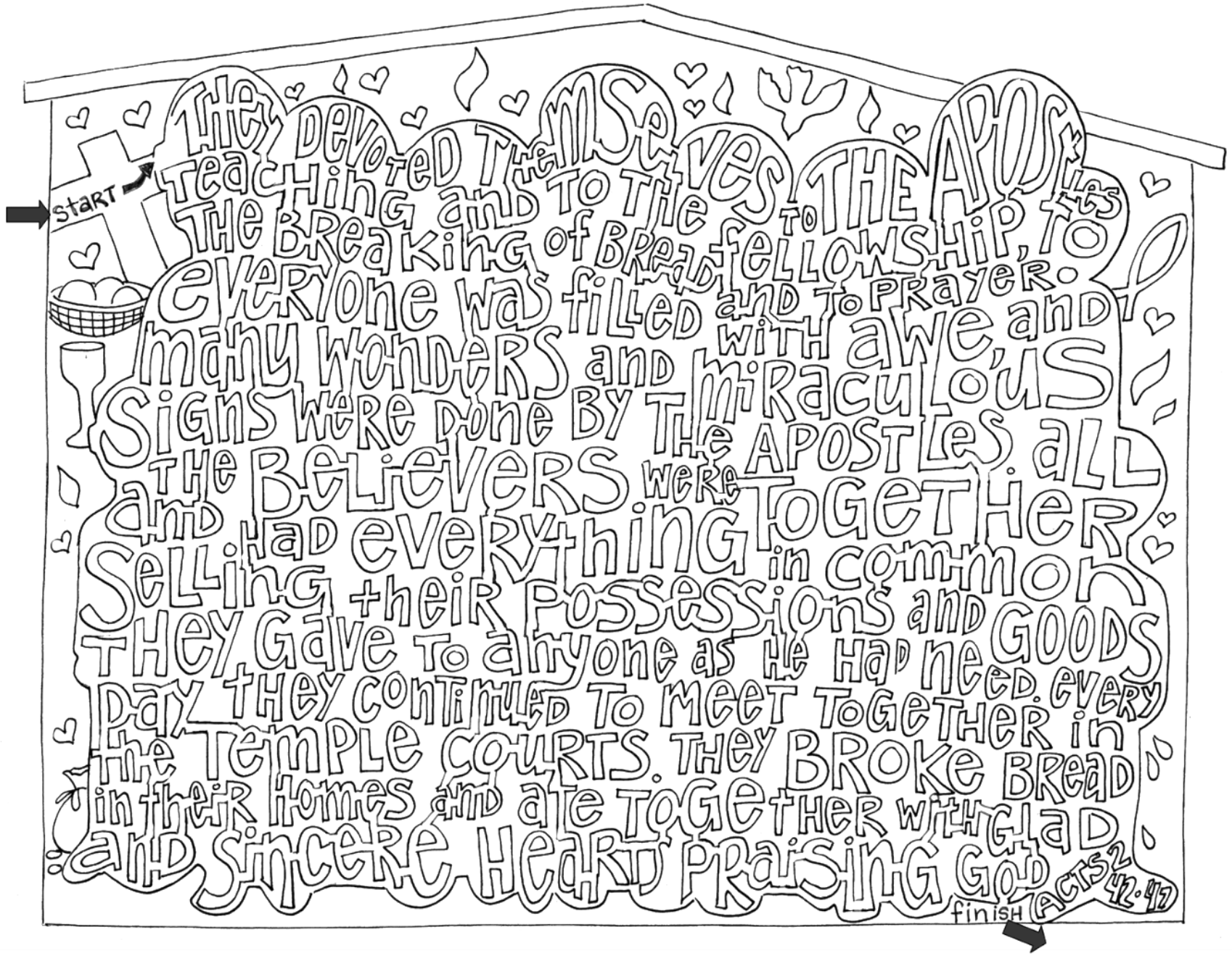
We have two colouring sheets for you and two challenges:
